DESIGNATING THE FOLLOWING AS A MID-BLOCK "STOP" LOCATION: TELEGRAPH HILL BOULEVARD, AT EAST END OF KEARNY STEPS, CROSSING TELEGRAPH HILL BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic and the Department of Public Works have analyzed plans for a proposed crosswalk on Telegraph Hill Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, It is the opinion of these Departments that the proposed configuration, including the proposed warning devices, represents a reasonable solution to the pedestrian access problem on Telegraph Hill; and

WHEREAS, These Departments believe that this configuration, if installed according to these plans, will be in compliance with all applicable statutes and regulations governing such installations; and

WHEREAS, The Parking and Traffic Commission, at its June 16, 1998 meeting, approved these plans; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That, pursuant to the provisions of the California Vehicle Code, the following location is hereby designated as a mid-block "Stop" location, and the Department of Parking and Traffic is hereby authorized and directed to cause "Stop" signs to be installed thereat as designated below:
