10	WHEREAS, Daniel Pearl, who played the violin, fiddle and mandolin in a broad
	selection of styles including classical, jazz, rock and bluegrass, has left behind a legacy of
11	unity, hope and friendship through music and words; and
12	WHEREAS, Daniel Pearl World Music Days, an annual event which takes place every
13	October around the globe, promotes a message of "Harmony for Humanity" in honor of the
14	birthday of Daniel Pearl;
15	WHEREAS, Warren Hellman and the Hardly Strictly Bluegrass Festival is spreading a
16	message of cultural and religious tolerance by dedicating performances to the memory of
17	Daniel Pearl during October; now, therefore, be it
18	RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors encourages its citizens to
	attend concerts and support musical artists in this noble endeavor; and be it
19	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby
20	proclaims October 10, 2007 as Daniel Pearl World Music Day in San Francisco.
