

1 [Assessment Appeals Board Local Procedural Rule Modification: Time period for Applicants to
2 request reconsideration after denial of application due to failure to appear at hearing.]

3 **Resolution approving modification of Assessment Appeals Board local Procedural**
4 **Rule 21 as approved by a joint meeting of AAB members, to improve hearing calendar**
5 **management by providing that an Applicant will have thirty (30) days (instead of the**
6 **current sixty (60) days) to file a request for reconsideration whenever the AAB has**
7 **denied an application due to the Applicant's failure to appear at the scheduled hearing.**

9 WHEREAS, Pursuant to local ordinance: "The Assessment Appeals Board shall hold
10 joint meetings from time to time for the purpose of proposing rules and regulations to the
11 Board of Supervisors to govern the operation of the Assessment Appeals Boards. . . ." (San
12 Francisco Administrative Code Chapter 2B, §2B.6(a)); and,

13 WHEREAS, Members of the Assessment Appeals Board (AAB) met in joint session on
14 August 4 and November 6, 2006 pursuant to §2B.6, to review their local Procedural Rules as
15 previously approved by the Board of Supervisors; and,

16 WHEREAS, A local Procedural Rule modification was proposed in order to more
17 efficiently manage the Board hearing calendar, by amending Section 21 so that when an
18 application for reduction of assessed property value is denied by the AAB due to the
19 Applicant's failure to appear for the scheduled hearing, the Applicant will then have 30 days
20 (instead of the current 60 days) to file a request for reconsideration with the AAB; and,

21 WHEREAS, This modification to Section 21 of the local Procedural Rules was
22 approved by the joint sessions of AAB members; and,

23 WHEREAS, Pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code §2B.6, Procedural Rules
24 must be forwarded to the Board of Supervisors for approval; and,

1 WHEREAS, The complete text of change to Assessment Appeals Board Procedural
2 Rule Section 21 as approved by the recent joint session of AAB members is on file with the
3 Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 061696, which is hereby declared to be a part
4 of this Resolution as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That modified Assessment Appeals Board Procedural Rule Section 21 is
6 approved by the Board of Supervisors pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code
7 Chapter 2B, §2B.6.


