4 WHEREAS, Dorothy M. Erlich is celebrating her 20th anniversary as Executive Director
5 of the American Civil Liberties Union of Northern California; and

6 WHEREAS, With Dorothy M. Erlich's outstanding leadership over the past 20 years, the
7 ACLU-NC has been at the forefront of the major civil liberties and civil rights struggles in San
8 Francisco throughout the state; and

9 WHEREAS, For two decades Dorothy has been a leading voice on civil liberties issues
10 from book banning to reproductive rights and from the death penalty to affirmative action,
11 among many others, and

12 WHEREAS, The ACLU-NC special projects created during Dorothy's tenure, such as
13 police practices, lesbian and gay rights, reproductive rights, death penalty, the Howard A.
14 Friedman First Amendment Education Project and the Radical Justice Project, have allowed
15 the ACLU-NC to focus its resources on the key civil liberties issues of the day; and

16 WHEREAS, Within the ACLU family and among her coalition friends within the civil
17 rights community, Dorothy is recognized as one of the great civil liberties leaders and civil
18 rights activists in the nation; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
20 hereby commends Dorothy M. Erlich for her commitment to civil rights and civil liberties and for
21 leading the ACLU of Northern California.
