ALU Recommendation: Approval with the following conditions:

- 1 Sales, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. each day of the week.
- 2 All sales and service of alcoholic beverages for consumption in the theater auditoriums shall be made only from concession stands, portable stands or bars, or fixed bars, and shall not be sold, served, or delivered to customers by individual ambulatory vendors, commonly known as “hawkers.”
- 3 Points of sale of alcoholic beverages shall not be maintained within the theater auditoriums.
- 4 Notwithstanding conditions #2 & #3, above, and only when the theater auditoriums is configured with designated seating, alcoholic beverages may be sold or served by waiters or waitresses in the general spectator seating areas under the following conditions:
 - a. Only persons occupying seats in the theater auditoriums shall be permitted to order and be served alcoholic beverages.
 - b. Orders from patrons seated in the theater auditoriums must be made to the waiter or waitress serving that area and the alcoholic beverages must be personally delivered to the patron by the waiter or waitress who took the order.
 - c. The waiter or waitress serving in the theater auditoriums shall not carry a supply of unordered alcoholic beverages.
- 5 No more than two (2) alcoholic beverages shall be sold or served to any one (1) person during any transaction.

- 6 Alcoholic beverages shall be served in containers which significantly differ in appearance from those containers utilized for non-alcoholic beverages. Containers for beer shall not exceed 16 ounces.
- 7 At all times when the premises is exercising the privileges of its license, an employee of the premises shall enter and monitor the activity within the theater auditoriums on a regular basis, but no less than once every 30 minutes.
- 8 Loitering (loitering is defined as “to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business”) is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee(s) as depicted on the ABC-257 dated 2-12-17.
- 9 Noise shall not be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee as depicted on ABC-257 dated 2-12-17.
- 10 The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited.

It should be noted that the applicant has agreed with the above listed recommended conditions.

Cutting Ball Theater was founded by Rob Melrose and Paige Rogers in 1999 and has been in residence at Exit on Taylor, located at 277 Taylor Street, since 2007. We are an award-winning theater company that produces a season of three full-length productions, with a total of 48-60 performances each year.

We are seeking this Type 64 liquor license so we can serve alcoholic beverages to our audiences during pre-show and intermission. This would allow us to join the rest of the theaters in our neighborhood in offering this option to our patrons. Alcoholic beverages would only be available to ticketed patrons of the shows during regular performances. Our normal operating hours are from Wednesday- Sunday between 5 pm – 10 pm, depending on the night of the week and the length of the show.

Currently we have found that on nights when we have daily liquor licenses, we are able to draw larger audiences to our theater. Audiences expect, from experience at other institutions such as A.C.T., the Magic Theater or Piano Fight, to be able to enjoy a glass of wine or a drink before a show. This license would therefore help us draw more audiences to our neighborhood and help provide a positive influx of foot traffic at night to the heart of the Tenderloin. As our audiences are drawn from all over the city, it will also help enhance the arts experience for patrons from across San Francisco, thereby serving public convenience or necessity. 
