[Evaluating the non-name HIV reporting system in California.]

WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant award from the State of California, Department of Health Services (DHS), for the conduct of a program entitled "Evaluating the Non-Name HIV Reporting System in California"; and,

WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interests of DHS, UCSF and SFDPH, AIDS to participate in this program; and,

WHEREAS, UCSF has agreed to reimburse SFDPH, AIDS in the amount of \$10,500 from this award; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds UCSF requires SFDPH, AIDS to enter into the second year of a subcontract (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 032013, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The subcontract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$1,125; and,

WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors because the Department did not receive the UCSF subcontract until November 18, 2003; and

WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds may be placed automatically on consent agendas in committee, as they are usually considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure of grant funding; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That SFDPH, AIDS is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into the second year of a subcontract agreement in the amount of \$10,500 with UCSF, the primary contractor, for services under the "Evaluating the Non-Name HIV Reporting System in California" program; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the agreement expires.
