Proposed First Amendment

►Resolution: Approve the first amendment to the grant agreement between HSH and Mission Neighborhood Centers for homelessness prevention assistance.

∽Term:

- Current Term: August 1, 2022 June 30, 2025
- Amended Term: August 1, 2022 June 30, 2028
- **►Amount:** Increases not-to-exceed amount by \$13,104,262 for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$20,633,600.
- **Commission Approval:** Reviewed and approved on September 5, 2024. →



Grant Amendment Overview

- Continue services provided by Mission Neighborhood Centers for at least 225 clients through June 30, 2026, decreasing to at least 120 clients in future fiscal years based on funding availability.
- **∽** Services include:
 - Flexible financial assistance including back rent, future rent and move-in assistance.
 - Housing Focused Referrals including budgeting and money management, legal services, public benefits, etc.
- ► Includes one-time funds in FY 24-25 to serve up to 685 existing tenants in PSH who owe back rent.
- → 75% of the annual budget is for direct client assistance. The remaining 25% supports operations and staffing.

SF Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)

SF ERAP **prevents homelessness** for over **2,300** households each
year.



Program Context

- ► Mission Neighborhood Centers (MNC) has administered this program since its launch in 2022.
- In FY 23-24, MNC prevented homelessness for 364 households.
- → Average amount of prevention assistance by household: \$5,887
 - 62% for back-rent
 - 19% future rent
 - 16% move-in assistance
