**Resolution enacting and rescinding traffic regulations on various streets.**

RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the movement of vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

**BICYCLE LANES - ESTABLISH**

Market Street, westbound, from Van Ness Avenue to Octavia Boulevard, and eastbound, from Gough Street to 12<sup>th</sup> Street.

Categorically exempt from Environmental Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and parking regulations where such changes do not establish a higher speed limit or result in more than a negligible increase in the use of the street.
