**WHEREAS**, the use and occupancy of Facility #1621 significantly benefits the Police Department's Wilderness Program which in turn provides outdoor activities to targeted youth from San Francisco; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED**, that the Chief of Police is authorized to execute a hold harmless agreement with the United States Department of the Interior contained in a Special Use Permit.


