

1 [Appointments - Bay Area Regional Interoperable Communications System Joint Powers  
2 Authority]

4 **Motion appointing Chief Gregory Suhr and Commander Lyn Tomioka, for indefinite**  
5 **terms, to the Bay Area Regional Interoperable Communications System Authority,**  
6 **residency requirement waived.**

7           MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does  
8 hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as a member and an alternate  
9 member of the Bay Area Regional Interoperable Communications System Joint Powers  
10 Authority, pursuant to the provisions of Board of Supervisors Resolution No. 223-11, for the  
11 terms specified:

12           Chief Gregory Suhr, seat 1, must be an employee of the City and County of San  
13 Francisco and should have significant public safety or related experience, for an indefinite  
14 term.

15           Commander Lyn Tomioka (residency requirement waived), seat 2 (alternate), must be  
16 an employee of the City and County of San Francisco and should have significant public  
17 safety or related experience, for an indefinite term.

18           FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 19           1. The membership of the Bay Area Regional Interoperable Communications System  
20           Joint Powers Authority has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City  
21           and County of San Francisco.
- 22           2. Applicant Commander Lyn Tomioka, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San  
23           Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the  
24           Bay Area Regional Interoperable Communications System Joint Powers Authority.

1           3. The Bay Area Regional Interoperable Communications System Joint Powers  
2           Authority has attempted to fill the position, for which Commander Lyn Tomioka was  
3           nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the specific  
4           experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The  
5           Rules Committee has certified that Commander Lyn Tomioka is qualified to serve  
6           on the Bay Area Regional Interoperable Communications System Joint Powers  
7           Authority.

8           4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no  
9           other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the  
10          specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is  
11          willing to serve on the Bay Area Regional Interoperable Communications System  
12          Joint Powers Authority at this time; and, be it

13          FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement  
14          for Commander Lyn Tomioka, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to  
15          serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s)  
16          appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the  
17          Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
