6 WHEREAS, For over 90% of the 1.8 million Americans who fought in the Korean War
7 from 1950-1953, the very last image they had of the United States was San Francisco until
8 they returned home from the war; and,

9 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Bay Area was a major hub of military activity, being the
10 gateway to the Far East for all support, including processing servicemen and women
11 transiting through and sending supply ships; and,

12 WHEREAS, The Marines' Memorial Association, in coordination with the Department of
13 the Navy, and on behalf of the three Sea Services, will host the final official commemorative
14 event "The Capstone Commemoration of the Korean War, 1950-1953" to honor and
15 remember all Korean War veterans and their families on October 10, 2003 in San Francisco;
16 now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
18 commemorates honors and remembers all Korean War Veterans and families on the 50th
19 anniversary of the Korean War.


