11 will” employment condition of these workers; and,

12 WHEREAS, Over 200 San Francisco Superior Court employees, who are also  
13 members of SEIU Local 790 Superior Court Chapter, have signed a petition requesting these  
14 reasonable demands; now, therefore, be it
