## CEQA GUIDELINES: 15269 (C)- EMERGENCY PROJECTS

Specific actions necessary to prevent or mitigate an emergency. This does not include long-term projects undertaken for the purpose of preventing or mitigating a situation that has a low probability of occurrence in the short-term...

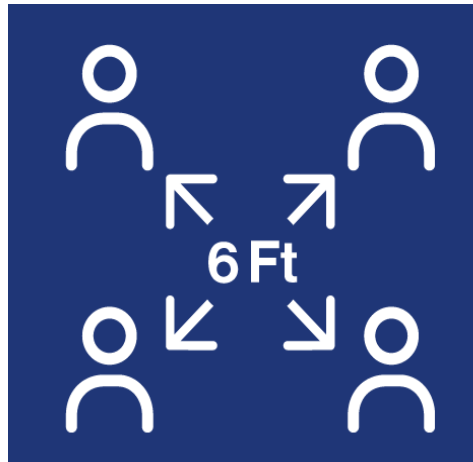
## **PUBLIC RESOURCES: § 21060.3. EMERGENCY**

“Emergency” means a sudden, unexpected occurrence, involving a clear and imminent danger, **demanding immediate action to prevent or mitigate loss of, or damage to, life, health, property, or essential public services.** “Emergency” includes such occurrences as fire, flood, earthquake, or other soil or geologic movements, as well as such occurrences as riot, accident, or sabotage.

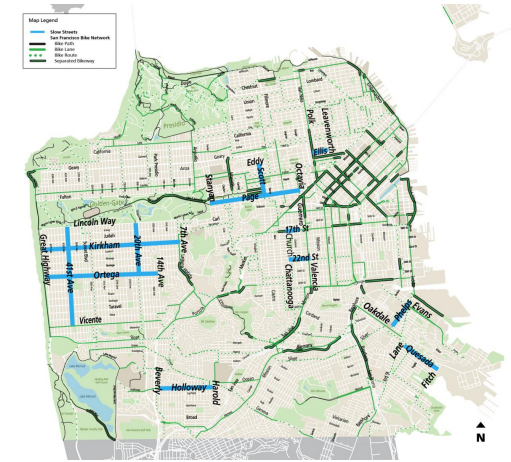
# ACTIONS TO PREVENT OR MITIGATE AN EMERGENCY



**MARCH 6<sup>TH</sup>:** SFDPH declared a health emergency



**MARCH 31<sup>ST</sup>:** Public Health order C19-07-Social Distancing



**April 21<sup>ST</sup> :** Slow Streets Phase 1 CEQA issued.
