Resolution urging the Director of the Department of Human Services to permanently locate the San Francisco Day Laborer Program at the 3120 Mission Street site and to negotiate with the current owners of the Department's intentions.

WHEREAS, For the past eleven years the San Francisco Day Labor Program has provided comprehensive services to thousands of San Francisco's day laborers and facilitated the education, empowerment and organizing of day laborers; and

WHEREAS, The Day Laborer Program has operated for the past eleven years from two portable trailers and under deplorable and difficult working conditions; and

WHEREAS, The Program was strategically located on 17th and Hampshire Street near Cesar Chavez Boulevard where the majority of day laborers congregate; and

WHEREAS, The location at 17th Street was to have been temporary until a permanent location on Cesar Chavez could located; and

WHEREAS, The Program staff has diligently searched for appropriate location and has faced numerous obstacles, primarily from a minority of community residents; and

WHEREAS, A substantial number of neighborhood residents and merchants have voiced their support of the program;

WHEREAS, Currently the Program is negotiating with the Department of Human Services (DHS) to sub-lease space in the building formerly occupied by the Employment Development Department (EDD) located at 3120 Mission Street; and

WHEREAS, The building located at 3120 Mission Street is privately owned by KLWLLC and DHS will be primary tenant; and

WHEREAS, The rear part of the 3120 Mission Street site appears to be an appropriate site for the permanent location of the San Francisco Day Laborer Program; and

WHEREAS, It is in the interest of the Board of Supervisors and citizens of San Francisco to do facilitate the creation of programs that can ameliorate the problem of unemployment and address the social needs of a population that is marginalized and underserved; be it therefore

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco strongly urges the Director of the Department of Human to permanently locate the San Francisco Day Laborer Program at the 3120 Mission Street site and to negotiate with the current owners of the Department's intentions; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors request that copies of this resolution be transmitted to the Director of the Department of Human Services as well as to the current owners of the 3120 Mission Street site.
