7	WHEREAS, 2025 marks the 175th anniversary of the First Unitarian Universalist
8	Society of San Francisco, a historic spiritual and social force that has long served as a beacon
9	of justice, compassion, and progressive values in the heart of the City; and
10	WHEREAS, Since its founding in 1850, the First Unitarian Universalist Society of San
11	Francisco has provided a welcoming spiritual home for those seeking personal growth,
12	community belonging, and collective action grounded in love and reason; and
13	WHEREAS, The congregation has upheld a deep and unwavering commitment to
14	advancing social justice, standing at the forefront of historic movements including abolition,
15	women's suffrage, LGBTQ+ rights, racial equity, immigrant justice, and environmental
16	stewardship; and
17	WHEREAS, The Society's landmark building at 1187 Franklin Street, constructed in
18	1889 and designated a San Francisco Landmark, is not only a sacred space for worship but
19	also a sanctuary for the arts, music, learning, and public discourse; and
20	WHEREAS, The Society is home to vibrant worship services, music programs, social
21	justice teams, and spiritual education for all ages, reflecting its mission to foster spiritual
22	growth and act for justice in the world; and
23	WHEREAS, Over the course of 175 years, the First Unitarian Universalist Society of
