

REVISED LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

(2/3/2026, Amended in Board)

[Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - Bloomberg Philanthropies - Innovation Team Grant and Amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance for FYs 2025-2026 and FYs 2026-2027 - \$7,000,000]

Ordinance authorizing the Mayor's Office to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$7,000,000 from Bloomberg Philanthropies to fund the Mayor's Office of Innovation from January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2028; approving the associated grant agreement under Charter, Section 9.118; and amending Ordinance No. 120-25 (Annual Salary Ordinance, File No. 250590 for Fiscal Years (FYs) 2025-2026 and 2026-2027) to provide for the creation of four grant-funded full-time positions (4.0 FTE) in the Office of the City Administrator, with one position in each of the following classes: Class 0931 (Manager III), Class 1053 (IS Business Analyst - Senior), Class 1054 (IS Business Analyst - Principal), and Class 1043 (IS Engineer - Senior).

Proposed Accept and Expend Ordinance

The ordinance would authorize the Mayor's Office to enter into an agreement to retroactively accept and expend \$7,000,000 from Bloomberg Philanthropies to fund the Mayor's Office of Innovation over the next three calendar years. The Mayor's Office of Innovation would use the grant funds to lead projects that support the Mayor's top priorities for San Francisco, such as clean, safe streets and economic revitalization. The ordinance would also create four grant-funded positions in the Office of the City Administrator to support this work, in Class 0931 (Manager III), Class 1053 (IS Business Analyst – Senior), Class 1054 (IS Business Analyst – Principal), and Class 1043 (IS Engineer – Senior).
