

1 [Accept-Expend State Grant funds available under the Roberti Z’Berg-Harris Block Grant
2 Program to fund the renovation of the Palace of Fine Arts, \$3,250,000; Stern Grove/Pine
3 Lake Meadow, \$1,450,000; and Geneva Office Building/Car Barn, \$42,243.]

5 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Recreation & Park Department to accept and**
6 **expend funds available under The Roberti-Z’berg-Harris Block Grant Program under**
7 **the California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks, and Coastal**
8 **Protection Act of 2002 in the amount of \$4,742,243.**
9

10 WHEREAS, The people of the State of California have enacted the California Clean
11 Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks and Coastal Protection Act of 2002 which
12 provides funds for the Roberti-Z’Berg-Harris Block Grant Program for grants to eligible
13 Applicants, and
14

15 WHEREAS, The California Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated
16 the responsibility for the administration of the program within the State, setting up necessary
17 procedures, and
18

19 WHEREAS, Said procedures established by the California Department of Parks and
20 Recreation require the Applicant’s Governing Body to certify by resolution the approval of the
21 Applicant to apply for the Roberti-Z’Berg-Harris allocation; and
22

23 WHEREAS, The Applicant will enter into a Contract with the State of California for the
24 Project; and
25

WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City and County of San Francisco
2 Board of Supervisors hereby:

3 Approves the acceptance and expenditure of local assistance funds from the Roberti-
4 Z'Berg-Harris Block Grant Program under the California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe
5 Neighborhood Parks and Coastal Protection Act of 2002; and

6 Certifies that the Applicant has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the
7 Project(s); and

8 Waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget;

9 Certifies that the Applicant has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the General
10 provisions contained in the Contract shown in the Procedural Guide; and

11 Certifies that the Project conforms to the recreation element of any applicable city or
12 county general plan; and

13 Appoints the General Manager of the Recreation & Park Department as agent to
14 conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to,
15 Applications, agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the
16 completion of the Project.
