1 FEDERAL GRANT
2 AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF CULTURAL AFFAIRS OF THE ARTS COMMISSION
3 TO RETROACTIVELY ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$22, 732
4 FROM THE SAN FRANCISCO URBAN RESOURCES PARTNERSHIP WHICH IS
5 ADMINSTRATED THROUGH THE NATURAL RESOURCES CONSERVATION SERVICE, THE
6 FOREST SERVICE OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND THE
7 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE RESTORATION OF THE ENDANGERED
8 GARDEN PUBLIC ART PROJECT AT THE SUNNYDALE PUMP STATION.

9 WHEREAS, The nationwide Urban Resources Partnership (URP)
10 program established the San Francisco Urban Resources Partnership
11 (SF-URP) in 1995; and,

12 WHEREAS, The URP program assists urban communities in improving
13 their natural resources, particularly soil and urban forests, and to
14 develop greater cooperation among all natural resource agencies,
15 organizations and individuals; and,

16 WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 3.19 of the San Francisco
17 Administrative Code, the City had allocated funds to construct the
18 *Endangered Garden Artwork* for the Sunnydale Pump Station Project, and
19 had authorized the Commission to supervise and control the
20 expenditure of funds for this artwork; and,

21 WHEREAS, The Artist was selected by a selection panel appointed
22 by the Commission's Visual Arts Committee and approved by the
23 Commission to create the Artwork at the Sunnydale Pump Station
24 Project. Copy which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
25 Supervisors in File No. 992142 ; and,

1 WHEREAS, The Arts Commission through a series of meetings with
2 the community and staff from various City departments, determined
3 that soil amendments and additional planting should be performed on
4 the Butterfly Meadow of the Endangered Garden, in keeping with the
5 artist's original intention to provide a restored habitat for other
6 indigenous plant species and wildlife; and,


7 WHEREAS, The SF-URP has recommended the award of up to \$22,732
8 to the Arts Commission of URP: Forest Service of the United States
9 Department of Agriculture funds for soil restoration and planting at
10 the Endangered Garden project at the Sunnydale Pump Station; now,
11 therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize
13 the Director of the Arts Commission to accept and expend \$22,732 in
14 federal funds granted through the San Francisco Urban Resources
15 Partnership, and to execute any and all documents necessary
16 therefore ; and be it


17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the 2% associated costs are hereby

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
