Proclamation of the City and County of San Francisco to declare July 7, 2008 as Peace and Dignity Day

RESOLVED, San Francisco is honored to take part in this historic journey aimed at bringing Peace and Dignity to all Indigenous nations, communities, and pueblos from Alaska to Argentina; and be it,

FURTHER RESOLVED, that July 7, 2008 is hereby declared as Peace and Dignity Day in San Francisco by the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco.
