12 Golf Course, which is located in Pacifica; and,

13 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco supports and encourages the City of
14 Pacifica in its plan to provide a skate park for youth; now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the San Francisco Recreation and Park
16 Department to enter into a lease agreement with the City of Pacifica for use of the surplus portion of
17 Sharp Park Golf Course to be used solely for the purpose of creating a community skate park.




