

## **LEGISLATIVE DIGEST**

[Administrative Code - Approval of Amended Airport Surveillance Technology Policy]

**Ordinance approving Amended Airport Surveillance Technology Policy governing the use of Pre-Security Cameras; and making required findings in support of said approvals.**

### **Background Information**

Administrative Code Chapter 19B (Chapter 19B) regulates City Departments' acquisition and use of Surveillance Technology. The Airport Commission (Airport) seeks to further amend its Surveillance Technology Policy for Pre-Security Cameras (Amended Surveillance Technology Policy).

Under the existing ordinance, the Airport uses the Pre-Security Cameras for: (1) live monitoring; (2) recording of video and images; (3) reviewing camera footage in the event of an incident; and (4) providing video footage/images to law enforcement or other authorized persons following an incident or upon request. The Amended Surveillance Technology Policy further describes the technology adding (1) mobile cameras for remote locations and traffic flow surveys, and (2) mobile and fixed cameras for Airport Incident, Passenger, and Roadway Traffic Monitoring.
