

1 [Contract Prop J: Facility Security Services]

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3 **Resolution concurring with the Controller’s certification that facility security services**
4 **for the Municipal Transportation Agency can be practically performed by a private**
5 **contractor at a lower cost than by City and County Employees.**

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7 WHEREAS, Section 10.104.15 of the San Francisco Charter allows Departments to
8 contract for services performed by employees subject to civil service examination when it has
9 been determined by the Controller that the work can be practically performed under private
10 contract at a lesser cost to the City than similar work performed by employees; and,

11 WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency desires to provide comprehensive
12 facility security services to protect its assets and employees through a private security
13 contractor; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Office of the Controller has certified that for fiscal year 2001-02,
15 contracting for facility security services with a private contractor is more economical than
16 providing the same services with City and County employees; and,

17 WHEREAS, The Controller’s certification is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
18 Supervisors in File No. _____ ; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors concurs with and adopt the Controller’s
20 certification that facility security services for the Municipal Transportation Agency can be
21 practically performed by a private contractor at a lower cost than by City and County
22 employees for fiscal year 2001-02.

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
