[Support S 314 — Loan Guarantee Program to Address Small Business Y2K Concerns]

URGING THE UNITED STATES SENATE TO APPROVE SENATE BILL 314 WHICH PROVIDES FOR A LOAN GUARANTEE PROGRAM TO ADDRESS THE YEAR 2000 COMPUTER PROBLEMS OF SMALL BUSINESS CONCERNS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, United States Senate Bill 107, introduced by Senator Bond, would provide for a loan guarantee program to address the Year 2000 (Y2K) problems of small business; and,

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 314 requires the Small Business Administration (SBA) to establish a loan guarantee program under which the SBA may guarantee loans to small businesses to address the Y2K computer problems of such businesses; and,

WHEREAS, Any lender eligible to participate in SBA's 7(a) business loan program is eligible to participate in the Y2K loan program; and,

WHEREAS, This includes more than 6,000 lenders nationwide; and,

WHEREAS, Small businesses may only use loan proceeds for two purposes: (1) a business may correct Y2K computer problems affecting its own information technology systems and other automated systems; and (2) a small business may use loan proceeds to provide relief from economic injuries suffered as a direct result of its own Y2K computer problems or some other entity's Y2K computer problems; and,

WHEREAS, Many small businesses do not have the necessary resources to address their possible Y2K problems; and,

WHEREAS, This economic disadvantage can be mitigated with the passage of this bill, giving small businesses the capital they need to survive the Y2K crisis; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco supports S 314 and urges its expeditious passage by the United States Senate.
