Ordinance appropriating \$5,428,603 from the General Reserve, de-appropriating \$86,621,397 from salaries, mandatory fringe benefits, equipment, and materials and supplies and appropriating \$61,000,000 to overtime in the Police Department and \$30,000,000 to overtime in the Sheriff's Department in order to support the Departments' projected increases in overtime as required per Administrative Code, Section 3.17, and \$1,050,000 to building maintenance services and building and structure improvement projects in the Sheriff's Department in Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-2025. Vice Chair Dorsey, seconded by Chair Chan, moved that this Ordinance be AMENDED, AN AMENDMENT OF THE WHOLE BEARING NEW TITLE, on Page 1, Lines 1-3, to read 'De-Appropriation -Salaries/Benefits/Vehicles, Various Projects - Police and Sheriff's Department - \$86,310,081 -Appropriation - General Fund - \$5,739,919 - Overtime/Building and Structure Improvement Projects/Repair - POL/SHF - \$92,050,000 - FY2024-2025'; on Page 1, Lines 5-14, to read 'Ordinance appropriating \$5,428,603 from the General Reserve and \$311,316 of Boarding of Prisoners revenue, de-appropriating \$86,310,081 from salaries, mandatory fringe benefits, vehicles, programmatic projects, capital renewal projects, and building and structure improvement projects and appropriating \$61,000,000 to overtime in the Police Department and \$30,000,000 to overtime in the Sheriff's Department in order to support the Departments' projected increases in overtime as required per Administrative Code Section 3.17, and \$1.050.000 to building and structure improvement projects and building repair in the Sheriff's Department.'; on Page 2, Lines 11-17, by adding an appropriation of \$311,316 and increasing the total sources appropriation amount for the Sheriff's Department from '\$5,428,603' to '\$5,739,919'; on Page 3, Lines 5-16, by reallocating amounts from permanent salaries, premium pay, and dependent coverage resulting in no change to the uses de-appropriation subtotal of \$61,000,000 for the Police Department; on Page 3, Line 22, through Page 5, Line 25, by adjusting, striking, and adding amounts from permanent salaries, retirement, automotive and other vehicles, capital renewal projects, and buildings and structure improvement projects resulting in a reduction in the uses de-appropriation subtotal from '\$25,621,397' to '\$25,310,081' for the Sheriff's Department, and adjusting the Total Uses De-appropriation amount from '\$86,621,397' to '\$86,310,081'; on Page 6, Line 15, through Page 9, Line 24, by striking and reallocating amounts from overtime, building maintenance, building and structure improvement projects, and building repair, resulting in no change to the uses appropriation amount subtotal of \$31,050,000 for the Sheriff's Department; and by making other clarifying and conforming changes to the Controller's chartfields throughout the ordinance text.
