

1 [Appointment – Veterans Affairs Commission]

3 **Resolution appointing Jill Buck, term ending January 31, 2010, Edwin Wilkerson, Bud**  
4 **Wilson and Regalado Baldonado, terms ending January 31, 2011, to the Veterans**  
5 **Affairs Commission; residency requirement waived.**

7           RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
8 does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Veterans  
9 Affairs Commission, pursuant to the provisions of the San Francisco Administrative Code,  
10 Section 5.102, for the term specified:

11           Jill Buck, succeeding herself (residency requirement waived), term expired, seat 5,  
12 must be a woman veteran, for the unexpired portion of a four-year term ending January 31,  
13 2010;

14           Edwin Wilkerson, succeeding Ralph Gibson, Sr., term expired, seat 7, must be a  
15 person who served in the Armed Forces of the United States of America and is suffering  
16 under a physical disability arising from that service, in accordance with the definitions applied  
17 in such cases by the Veterans' Administration, for a new four-year term ending January 31,  
18 2011;

19           Bud Wilson, succeeding himself, term expired, seat 8, must be an at-large  
20 appointment, for a new four-year term ending January 31, 2011;

21           Regalado Baldonado, succeeding Edwin Wilkerson, term expired, seat 11, must be an  
22 at-large appointment, for a new four-year term ending January 31, 2011; and, be it

23           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 24           1. The membership of the Veterans Affairs Commission has a goal to be  
25           representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.

- 1           2. Applicant Jill Buck, an appointee who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person  
2           with experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Veterans Affairs  
3           Commission.
- 4           3. The Veterans Affairs Commission has attempted to fill the position, for which Jill  
5           Buck was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the  
6           specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this  
7           time. The Rules Committee has certified that Jill Buck is qualified to serve on the  
8           Veterans Affairs Commission.
- 9           4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no  
10          other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the  
11          specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is  
12          willing to serve on the Veterans Affairs Commission at this time; and, be it

13          FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency  
14          requirement for Jill Buck, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve,  
15          can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed  
16          to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of  
17          Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
