WHEREAS, The Sing Tao Daily is currently celebrating its 65th year anniversary of being a major force in raising awareness of local issues important to the Chinese community; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco commends the Sing Tao Daily for 65 years of outstanding contributions to the Chinese community, raising the awareness of local issues, and enabling the Chinese speaking community to participate in the political process in San Francisco.
