

1 [State grants to support environmental health projects.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to**
4 **retroactively accept and expend two grants totaling \$4,948.18, one from the California**
5 **Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) and one from the California Department of**
6 **Pesticide Regulation (CDPR); for the period of July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.**

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8 WHEREAS, DPH was awarded two grants to support environmental health projects
9 including one from the CDFA, Egg Quality Control (\$2,256.18) to monitor egg quality at
10 production, wholesale and retail levels, and one from the CDPR, Pesticide Use Reporting
11 (\$2,692) to gather county information regarding the trends of pesticide use; and,

12 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the CDFA and CDPR require
13 the City to comply with the terms of two separate agreements (the "Agreements"), copies of
14 which are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____,
15 which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

16 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget for
17 both grants; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend two
19 grants in the total amount of \$4,948.18 from the CDFA and CDPR; and, be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
21 indirect costs in the budget of the two Agreements; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
23 Agreements on behalf of the City.
