

1 [Requirements Suspended for Certain Transient Merchants]
 2 AMENDING ARTICLE 3 OF PART III OF THE SAN FRANCISCO MUNICIPAL CODE, BY
 3 AMENDING SECTION 250, EXCEPTING CERTAIN TRANSIENT MERCHANTS THAT
 4 OPERATE AT MOSCONE CENTER OR THE BILL GRAHAM CIVIC AUDITORIUM AND
 5 AGREE TO COMPLY WITH ALL THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO'S RULES
 6 FROM THE LICENSING AND FEE REQUIREMENTS OTHERWISE APPLICABLE TO
 7 TRANSIENT MERCHANTS UNDER ARTICLE 3; AND ENABLING ENFORCEMENT BY
 8 MEANS OF CITATION.

10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 Section 1. Article 3 of Part III of the San Francisco Municipal Code is hereby amended
 12 by amending Section 250, to read as follows:

13 **SEC. 250. TRANSIENT MERCHANTS LICENSE REQUIRED.** Except as otherwise
 14 provided in Section 258 of this Article, ((I)) it shall be unlawful for a transient merchant as
 15 defined in Section 251 of this Article to engage in such business within the City and County of
 16 San Francisco without obtaining a license therefor in compliance with the provisions of this
 17 Article.

18 The provisions of this Article may be enforced by the issuance of citations under
 19 Section 6.19-1, and following, of Article 6 of Part III of the San Francisco Municipal Code.




