

1 [Cars Blocking Sidewalk Access Ramps]

2 URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC TO EXERCISE ALL DUE
3 SENSITIVITY TO THE DISABLED COMMUNITY IN RESPONDING TO COMPLAINTS AND IN
4 EXECUTING THE PROVISIONS OF THE TRAFFIC CODE WITH RESPECT TO THE OFFENSE
5 OF CARS ILLEGALLY BLOCKING SIDEWALK ACCESS RAMPS.

6 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco is committed to making the City accessible
7 to the disabled; and,

8 WHEREAS, Sidewalk access ramps exist so as to be accessible to and usable by the physically
9 disabled; and,

10 WHEREAS, Section 70b of the San Francisco Traffic Code provides that cars parked in such a
11 way as to obstruct sidewalk access ramps are subject to removal; now, therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby urge the Department of Parking and
13 Traffic to use all due sensitivity in responding to complaints and in executing the provisions of the
14 traffic code with respect to the offense of cars illegally blocking sidewalk access ramps; and, be it,

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board does hereby ask a copy of this resolution to be sent to
16 The Department of Parking and Traffic.


