14 plays in the lives of youth, offering numerous programs that reach out to students, teachers,
15 educational organizations; and,

16 WHEREAS, The Giants Community Fund continues its partnership with the "Until
17 There's A Cure Day Foundation" awarding grant money to Bay Area organizations that are
18 committed to the prevention and treatment of HIV/AIDS; and

19 WHEREAS, The Giants Community Fund works to educate the community about
20 family violence prevention solutions, awarding grants to local organizations that are
21 committed to ending family violence; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Giants Community Fund extensive contributions to the various
23 community programs and to the people of the City and County of San Francisco and to the
24 fans of the Giants is so overwhelming that they deserves public recognition; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors commend the
2 Giants Community Fund for their community involvement, which will have lasting impacts on
3 the quality and lives of Giants fans from Medford, Oregon to San Louis Obispo, California;


