#### First Amendment

## Agreement between the City and County of San Francisco and San Francisco Pretrial Diversion Project, Inc.

(Contract No. 1000021909)

THIS AMENDMENT (this "Amendment") is made as of **July 01, 2022** in San Francisco, California, by and between **San Francisco Pretrial Diversion Project, Inc.** ("Contractor"), and the City and County of San Francisco, a municipal corporation ("City"), acting by and through its Director of the Office of Contract Administration.

#### Recitals

WHEREAS, City and Contractor have entered into the Agreement (as defined below); and

WHEREAS, City and Contractor desire to modify the Agreement on the terms and conditions set forth herein to increase the contract amount by adding a Cost of Doing Business increase for FY2022-2023; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement was competitively procured as required by San Francisco Administrative Code Chapter 21.1 through RFP SHF2020-04/Event No. 0000004830 - Pretrial Services, a Request for Proposal ("RFP") issued on December 22, 2020 and this modification is consistent therewith; and

WHEREAS, approval for the original Agreement was obtained on November 16, 2020 from the Civil Service Commission under PSC number 44812-20/21 in the amount of \$19,830,206 for the period of three years; and

WHEREAS, the City's Board of Supervisors approved this Agreement by Resolution No. 210484 dated on June 15, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, Contractor and the City agree as follows:

#### **Article 1 Definitions**

The following definitions shall apply to this Amendment:

1.1 **Agreement.** The term "Agreement" shall mean the Agreement dated July 01, 2021 between Contractor and City, Contract ID: 1000021909, as amended by the:

First Amendment, dated July 01, 2022, and

1.2 **Other Terms.** Terms used and not defined in this Amendment shall have the meanings assigned to such terms in the Agreement.

#### **Article 2 Modifications of Scope to the Agreement**

#### The Agreement is hereby modified as follows:

- 2.1 **Compensation.** Section 3.3.1 Calculation of Charges of the Agreement currently reads as follows:
- 3.3.1 Calculation of Charges. Contractor shall provide an invoice to the City on a monthly basis for goods delivered and/or Services completed in the immediate preceding month, unless a different schedule is set out in Appendix B, "Calculation of Charges." Compensation shall be made for goods and/or Services identified in the invoice that the City, in his or her sole discretion, concludes has been satisfactorily performed. In no event shall the amount of this Agreement exceed \$18,764,430 (Eighteen Million Seven Hundred Sixty Four Thousand Four Hundred Thirty Dollars). The breakdown of charges associated with this Agreement appears in Appendix B, "Calculation of Charges." A portion of payment may be withheld until conclusion of the Agreement if agreed to by both Parties as retainage, described in Appendix B. In no event shall City be liable for interest or late charges for any late payments. City will not honor minimum service order charges for any services covered by this Agreement.

#### Such section is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

- 3.3.1 Calculation of Charges. Contractor shall provide an invoice to the City on a monthly basis for goods delivered and/or Services completed in the immediate preceding month, unless a different schedule is set out in Appendix B, "Calculation of Charges." Compensation shall be made for goods and/or Services identified in the invoice that the City, in his or her sole discretion, concludes has been satisfactorily performed. In no event shall the amount of this Agreement exceed \$18,952,074 (Eighteen Million Nine Hundred Fifty Two Thousand Seventy Four). The breakdown of charges associated with this Agreement appears in Appendix B, "Calculation of Charges." A portion of payment may be withheld until conclusion of the Agreement if agreed to by both Parties as retainage, described in Appendix B. In no event shall City be liable for interest or late charges for any late payments. City will not honor minimum service order charges for any services covered by this Agreement.
- 2.2 **Appendix B-2A.** Appendix B-2A is hereby replaced in its entirety by Appendix B-2B, attached to this Amendment and fully incorporated within the Agreement. To the extent the Agreement refers to Appendix B-2A in any place, the true meaning shall be Appendix B-2B, which is a correct and updated version.
- 2.3 Qualified Personnel. <u>Section 4.2 Qualified Personnel of the Agreement currently reads as follows.</u>
- 4.2 **Qualified Personnel**. Contractor shall utilize only competent personnel under the supervision of, and in the employment of, Contractor (or Contractor's authorized subcontractors) to perform the Services. Contractor will comply with City's reasonable requests regarding

assignment and/or removal of personnel, but all personnel, including those assigned at City's request, must be supervised by Contractor. Contractor shall commit adequate resources to allow timely completion within the project schedule specified in this Agreement.

#### Such section is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

#### 4.2 **Personnel**.

4.2.1 Qualified Personnel. Contractor shall utilize only competent personnel under the supervision of, and in the employment of, Contractor (or Contractor's authorized subcontractors) to perform the Services. Contractor will comply with City's reasonable requests regarding assignment and/or removal of personnel, but all personnel, including those assigned at City's request, must be supervised by Contractor. Contractor shall commit adequate resources to allow timely completion within the project schedule specified in this Agreement.

#### 4.2.2 Contractor Vaccination Policy.

- (a) Contractor acknowledges that it has read the requirements of the 38th Supplement to Mayoral Proclamation Declaring the Existence of a Local Emergency ("Emergency Declaration"), dated February 25, 2020, and the Contractor Vaccination Policy for City Contractors issued by the City Administrator ("Contractor Vaccination Policy"), as those documents may be amended from time to time. A copy of the Contractor Vaccination Policy can be found at: https://sf.gov/confirm-vaccine-status-your-employees-and-subcontractors
- (b) A Contract subject to the Emergency Declaration is an agreement between the City and any other entity or individual and any subcontract under such agreement, where Covered Employees of the Contractor or Subcontractor work in-person with City employees in connection with the work or services performed under the agreement at a City owned, leased, or controlled facility. Such agreements include, but are not limited to, professional services contracts, general services contracts, public works contracts, and grants. Contract includes such agreements currently in place or entered into during the term of the Emergency Declaration. Contract does not include an agreement with a state or federal governmental entity or agreements that do not involve the City paying or receiving funds.
- (c) In accordance with the Contractor Vaccination Policy, Contractor agrees that:
  - (i) Where applicable, Contractor shall ensure it complies with the requirements of the Contractor Vaccination Policy pertaining to Covered Employees, as they are defined under the Emergency Declaration and the Contractor Vaccination Policy, and insure such Covered Employees are either fully vaccinated for COVID-19 or obtain from Contractor an exemption based on medical or religious grounds; and

(ii) If Contractor grants Covered Employees an exemption based on medical or religious grounds, Contractor will promptly notify City by completing and submitting the Covered Employees Granted Exemptions Form ("Exemptions Form"), which can be found at https://sf.gov/confirm-vaccine-status-your-employees-and-subcontractors (navigate to "Exemptions" to download the form).

#### **Article 3** Reserved. Updates of Standard Terms to the Agreement

#### **Article 4 Effective Date**

Each of the modifications set forth in Articles 2 and 3 shall be effective on and after **July 01, 2022.** 

#### Article 5 Legal Effect

Except as expressly modified by this Amendment, all of the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
