[Proposition J Certification for Jail Food Services]

**Resolution approving the Controller's certification that county jail food service management operations can practically be performed by a private contractor at a lower cost than if work were performed by City employees at budgeted levels.**

WHEREAS, The electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed Proposition J in November 1976, adding Section 10.104.15 to the Charter allowing City Departments to contract with private companies for specific services which can practically be performed for a lower cost than similar work by City and County employees; and

WHEREAS, The Controller has certified on January 26, 2005 that the services involved in the administration and provision of county jail food service management operations in the City and County of San Francisco for the year commencing March 1, 2005 can be performed at a lower cost to the City and County of San Francisco than if such services were performed by employees of the City and County of San Francisco; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That pursuant to Section 10.104.15 of the Charter, this Board of Supervisors hereby approves said Controller's certification.


