

1 [Report of Assessment Costs - Sidewalk Inspection and Repair Program]

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3 **Resolution approving report of assessment costs submitted by the Director of Public**
4 **Works for sidewalk and curb repairs through the Sidewalk Inspection and Repair**
5 **Program, ordered to be performed by said Director pursuant to the provisions of Public**
6 **Works Code, Section 706.9, and Administrative Code, Chapter 80, the costs thereof**
7 **having been paid for out of a revolving fund.**

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9 WHEREAS, Pursuant to the provisions of Public Works Code, Section 706.9, and
10 Administrative Code, Chapter 80, the Director of Public Works did cause the correction of
11 sidewalk conditions at various locations where the obligation to perform such correction is that
12 of the property owners; and

13 WHEREAS, Following public hearings on May 13, 2015, September 9, 2015, April 27,
14 2016, December 14, 2016, March 29, 2017, November 1, 2017, May 2, 2018, June 27, 2018,
15 January 9, 2019, February 6, 2019, February 13, 2019, March 6, 2019, August 14, 2019,
16 September 4, 2019, October 2, 2019, October 23, 2019, November 13, 2019, December 11,
17 2019, and January 29, 2020, the Director of Public Works considered objections to work done
18 or caused to be done through the Sidewalk Inspection and Repair Program pursuant to the
19 provisions of Public Works Code, Section 706.9 and Administrative Code, Chapter 80; and

20 WHEREAS, By Public Works Order No. 206299, the Director of Public Works approved
21 a Report of Assessment Costs for sidewalk and curb repairs through the Sidewalk Inspection
22 and Repair Program, ordered to be performed by said Director pursuant to the provisions of
23 Public Works Code, Section 706.9, and Administrative Code, Chapter 80, the costs thereof
24 having been paid for out of a revolving fund; and

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1 WHEREAS, On May 17, 2022, the Board of Supervisors held a duly-noticed public
2 hearing to consider the report of assessment costs; and

3 WHEREAS, Following the public hearing the Board of Supervisors made any
4 corrections, revisions, or modifications to the report as it deems necessary; now, therefore, be
5 it

6 RESOLVED, The Board does hereby confirm said Report of Assessment Cost
7 described in Public Works Order No. 206299; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this Resolution and a copy of said itemized
9 Report of Assessment Costs confirmed by the Board shall be transmitted to the Controller and
10 Tax Collector of the City and County, whereupon it shall be the duty of said officers to add the
11 amount of each assessment to the next regular bill for taxes levied against each respective
12 parcel of land, and thereafter each said amount shall be collected at the same time and in the
13 same manner as ordinary City and County taxes are collected, and shall be subject to the
14 same procedure under foreclosure and sale in case of delinquency as provided for ordinary
15 taxes of the City and County; and, be it

16 FURTHER RESOVED, That all monies received in payment of the assessments shall
17 be credited to the revolving fund provided for in Public Works Code, Section 706.8, except
18 that the portion of the assessments attributable to the cost of City Administration shall be
19 credited to the Administrative Account of Sidewalk Repair.
