Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$180,000 from the Metta Fund to support the Swine Flu Information and Guidance Team; for the period of October 6, 2009 through October 5, 2010.

WHEREAS, DPH's Communicable Disease Control and Prevention Section was awarded a grant from the Metta Fund, in the amount of \$180,000 for the period of October 6, 2009 through October 5, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, The purpose of this grant is to support four individuals who can respond to calls, develop information and assist with vaccination distribution planning for San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and partially reimburses the Department for four existing positions: two Physician Specialists (Job Class #2230) at 1.00 and 0.42 FTE and two Public Service Trainees (Job Class #9910) at 1.00 and 0.75 FTE for the period October 6, 2009 through October 5, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, The budget does not include a provision for indirect costs in order to maximize the use of grant funds on direct services; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively the grant from the Metta Fund in the amount of \$180,000; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when the agreement expires; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City.
