

## **Background on Annual Economic Statement**



In 2023, the Board of Supervisors passed amendments to Administrative Code Section 10.1 (Annual Economic Statement – City-Funded Organizations) which required nonprofits who receive more than \$100,000 from the City to make certain information publicly available.

The Office of the City Administrator, in partnership with the Controller's Office, developed a new process to implement this requirement which asked nonprofits to:

- Post the required information on their public website, and
- Report back to the City that they completed this posting.

Several nonprofits contacted the City to report that certain information required by the legislation could compromise personal safety of the organization and their staff.

President Mandelman introduced legislation allowing for redaction of information that could compromise public

## **Legislation overview & purpose**

If passed, this legislation would allow nonprofit organizations to **redact** the required Annual Economic Statement information in certain situations:



"to protect personal safety where an organization whose agents, employees, or officers have **received threats of violence** in the past year"



"or where an organization performs **similar work to another organization** whose agents, employees, or officers have received threats of violence in the past year."
