1	[Urging the United States to take action against the Republic of Sudan to end the genocide Darfur.]

4	Resolution urging the United States to take action against the Republic of Sudan to
5	end the genocide in Darfur.
6	
7	WHEREAS, Since February 2003, in the Republic of Sudan, a government-backed
8	militia known as Janjaweed has been engaging in a systematic program of expulsion, rape
9	and murderous violence in Darfur, Sudan. Government air raids have frequently preceded or
10	followed militia attacks. In violations of numerous U.N. resolutions and ceasefire agreements,
11	the attacks on civilians continue; and,
12	WHEREAS, More that two million people now live in crowded camps in Darfur and
13	Chad where disease and mortality rates are climbing. Those who venture from the camps
14	risk being attacked or raped; and,
15	WHEREAS, Only about half of those who were forced from their homes are receiving
16	aid; others are in camps that are not yet served, or are, literally, wandering the desert.
17	According the U.N. Food Program, 3.5 million people – more than half the population of
18	Darfur – are now in need of food; and,
19	WHEREAS, The African Union troops currently in Darfur are charged with monitoring
20	ceasefire agreements and escorting aid convoys, but they have no mandate to protect
21	civilians; and,
22	WHEREAS, Banditry, looting and continued violence threaten U.N. and non-
23	governmental aid workers. Many have been harassed, abducted, and even killed; and,
24	WHEREAS, U.N. agencies estimate that over 2.5 million people have been displaced
25	and 800,000 Darfurians are victims of genocide; and,

1	WHEREAS, the San Francisco Bay Area Darfur Coalition is organizing a vigil across
2	the Golden Gate Bridge at 10am on April 30 th 2006 and an interfaith service at 2pm on April
3	30 th at Crissy Field to raise awareness about Darfur. Participants in the vigil can preregister
4	in advance at www.ourpledge.org; and,
5	WHEREAS, U.S. President George W. Bush has repeatedly cited the killing of people
6	in Darfur as genocide; now, therefore, be it
7	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
8	hereby deplores the persecution and killing of all Darfurians who are the victims of genocide
9	in Sudan; and, be it
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
11	Francisco urges the U.S. and its allies to take strong measures against the Republic of Sudan
12	for their national practice of genocide of the Muslim people of Darfur.
