Proposed Amendment Details

► Resolution: Approve the third amendment to the grant agreement between HSH and Five Keys Schools and Programs (Five Keys) for Next Door shelter program.

∽Term:

- Current Term: December 1, 2020 June 30, 2025
- Amended Term: December 1, 2020 June 30, 2028
- **► Amount:** Increases the not-to-exceed amount by \$26,755,828 for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$59,204,930.
- **~** Commission approval: May 1, 2025





Grant Agreement Overview

- ► Next Door Shelter offers 24/7 emergency shelter for up to 334 adult guests per night.
- **~** Cost per bed per night = \$77*
- Services provided by Five Keys:
 - 24/7 emergency shelter
 - Two meals per day
 - Laundry
 - Case management
 - Department of Public Health's Shelter Health Clinic
 - Behavioral and mental health support
 - Substance abuse support







^{*}Cost does not include costs associated with the shelter health program provided by DPH or the cost of meals provided through a separate agreement with Meals on Wheels. No rent as this is a city-owned building.



Next Door Sleeping Area

Program Context

- ►Next Door is the largest congregate shelter in San Francisco.
- ► Located at 1001 Polk Street.
- ← Five Keys served **860 people** in Fiscal Year 2023-24 at Next Door.
- ► The average occupancy rate for Fiscal Year 23-24 was 93%, exceeding HSH's goal of 90%.
