# AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE 2023-2026 MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO

#### AND

### SAN FRANCISCO AND SAN FRANCISCO POLICE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION

The parties hereby agree to amend the Memorandum of Understanding as follows, subject to approval by the San Francisco Board of Supervisors.

## ARTICLE I- REPRESENTATION

Section 5. Grievance Procedure.

#### Arbitrator Panel

- 28. The City and the Association shall select a standing panel of arbitrators to hear grievances. The parties shall establish the panel in the following fashion: by not later than September 1, 2023, each party shall submit to the other, the names of seven (7) arbitrators and prepare a list with all arbitrators submitted by the parties. The parties shall then, beginning by lot, alternately strike names from the list until seven (7) names remain. The seven (7) remaining persons shall constitute the standing arbitration panel for the term of the Agreement. The City and the Association have selected the following individuals to serve as the standing panel of arbitrators to hear grievances for the term of the Agreement:
