3 DISTRICT PLAYING FIELDS AVAILABLE TO COMMUNITY MEMBERS FOR SOCCER AND

9 WHEREAS, The popularity of soccer has grown dramatically in  
10 recent years among San Franciscans; and,

11 WHEREAS, According to statistics from the California Youth  
12 Soccer Association (CYSA), the number of young registered soccer  
13 players in San Francisco has grown from 2,500 in 1992-1993 to close  
14 to 5,500 in 1998-99; and,

15 WHEREAS, Soccer has widespread participation from many  
16 communities without barriers of race, ethnicity or economic status;  
17 and,

18 WHEREAS, Soccer and other team sports provide young people with  
19 a positive environment to display their talents and creativity; and,

20 WHEREAS, There is a shortage of playing fields in San Francisco  
21 that are available to the community for soccer and other sports; and,

22 WHEREAS, A community-based soccer program for children 5 to 10  
23 years old has had to turn players away because there are not enough  
24 fields to accommodate them; now, therefore, be it




