

1 [Rescinding Yellow Zones]

2 **Resolution urging the Department of Parking and Traffic to convert parking spaces**  
3 **located at 3286 and 3290 Mission Street from metered yellow zones to standard parking**  
4 **metered parking.**

6 WHEREAS, Street parking located at 3286 and 3290 Mission Street are currently  
7 metered parking with yellow zone status; and

8 WHEREAS, The Bernal Heights Neighborhood Center, a non-profit organization  
9 dedicated to improvement of the Bernal Heights neighborhood, conducted a survey of the  
10 merchants of the 3200 block of Mission and ascertained that businesses located on the 3200  
11 block neither used nor required the use of metered yellow zone parking to conduct their  
12 business; and

13 WHEREAS, The businesses located on the 3200 block of Mission Street, Tiffany  
14 Gardens Development Corporation, Al's Good Food Café, and Touch of Class Beauty Salon  
15 further expressed the desire to convert the yellow zone to regular metered parking for their  
16 customers; and

17 WHEREAS, Merchants at the aforementioned locations also expressed that their  
18 customers complained about the lack of parking and that regular parking would encourage  
19 their patronage of those businesses; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
21 hereby urges the Department of Parking and Traffic to convert parking spaces located at 3286  
22 and 3290 Mission Street from metered yellow zones to standard parking metered parking.
