WHEREAS, Maarten Bon is seeking issuance of a Type 42 On-Sale beer and wine public premises license for Cork, located at 2111 Market Street; and,

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned; and,

WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the liquor license application be approved with conditions; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the issuance of a Type 42 On-Sale beer and wine public premises license to Maarten Bon for Cork, located at 2111 Market Street will serve the public convenience or necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco.

11:00 am and 12 Midnight Friday and Saturday; (2) No open and or resealed/re-corked containers of alcoholic beverages shall be removed from the premises; (3) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee(s); (4) No wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content greater than 15% by volume except "Dinner Wines" which have been aged two years or more and maintained in corded bottles; (5) There shall be no consumption of alcoholic beverages on the sidewalk area in front of or adjacent to the premises; (6) Petitioner shall not make structural changes in the premises interior without prior written approval from the Department; (7) The interior lighting maintained therein shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons and patrons in that portion of the premises where alcoholic beverages are sold, served, delivered or consumed; (8) The exterior of the premises shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the premises. Additionally, the position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences; (9) Loitering (loitering is defined as, "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalk or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee; (10) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control; (11) Graffiti shall be removed from the premises and all parking lots under the control of the licensee within 72 hours of application. If the graffiti occurs on a Friday or weekend day, or on a holiday, the licensee shall remove the graffiti with 72 hours following the beginning of the next weekday.




