8 WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has entered into an agreement dated
9 November 20, 2000 with Anshen+Allen/Gordon H. Chong & Partners, A Joint Venture for the
10 design of the Laguna Honda Hospital Replacement Program; and,

11 WHEREAS, the sum certified under said agreement is \$7,599,717; and,

12 WHEREAS, the Director intends to increase the scope of services under said
13 agreement and to increase the sum under said agreement by \$22,300,283; and,

14 WHEREAS, Section 9.118(b) of the Charter requires that all agreements in excess of
15 ten million dollars or amendments to said agreements in excess of \$500,000 be approved by
16 the Board of Supervisors; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the Director of
18 Public Works to enter into amendments to the November 20, 2000 agreement with
19 Anshen+Allen/Gordon H. Chong & Partners, A Joint Venture in an amount not to exceed
20 \$29,900,000.




