3 **Resolution authorizing the Recreation and Park Department to retroactively accept and**  
4 **expend a grant administered by the California State Parks and Recreation Department**  
5 **in the amount of \$2,700,000 for the 17<sup>th</sup> and Folsom Street Park Project.**

7 WHEREAS, The California State Department of Parks and Recreation has received an  
8 appropriation from the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River  
9 and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84) to administer the Statewide Park  
10 Program; and,

11 WHEREAS, The Statewide Park Program awards grants on a competitive basis for the  
12 creation of new parks in critically underserved communities across California; and,

13 WHEREAS, The 17<sup>th</sup> and Folsom Park Project will create a new park in one of the  
14 City's densest neighborhoods thereby meeting this grant objective; and,

15 WHEREAS, The Project is located within the open space opportunity area identified in  
16 the Eastern Neighborhoods Plan; and,

17 WHEREAS, The property is currently owned by the San Francisco Public Utilities  
18 Commission (SFPUC); and,

19 WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Department is in the process of acquiring the  
20 property from the SFPUC; and,

21 WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Commission approved the submittal,  
22 acceptance and expenditure of a Statewide Park Grant for the 17<sup>th</sup> and Folsom Park Project  
23 on January 21, 2010, under resolution No. 1001-002 ("Commission Resolution"); and,

24 WHEREAS, The California State Parks and Recreation Department approved funding  
25 for the 17<sup>th</sup> and Folsom Park Project in the amount of \$2,700,000; and,

1 WHEREAS, The California State Parks and Recreation Department approved funding  
2 for the 17<sup>th</sup> and Folsom Park Project in the amount of \$2,700,000; and,

3 WHEREAS, The grant performance period runs from July 1, 2009 through June 30,  
4 2017; and,


5 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO Amendment; and,

6 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,  
7 therefore, be it


8 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Recreation and Park

10 of \$2,700,000 for 17<sup>th</sup> and Folsom Park Project; and, be it


11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives inclusion of indirect
