WHEREAS, Our greatest opportunity lies in combining our strength as purchasers, working together to challenge the excessive charges, questioning the excessive and unjustified costs, demanding an end to the poor quality of care of hospitals, medical groups, and the health industry in general and focusing our purchasing power directly on providers; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco support the California Health Care Coalition of the California Works Foundation and will participate with other public and private purchasers determined to bring significantly greater performance accountability and transparency to the healthcare industry.
