

1 [Calling for the formation of the San Francisco-Brisbane Municipal Utility District]

3 **Motion declaring that in the Board's opinion the public interest or necessity demands**
4 **the creation and maintenance of a municipal utility district with the same exterior**
5 **boundaries as the City and County of San Francisco and the City of Brisbane, to be**
6 **known as the "San Francisco-Brisbane Municipal Utility District," and directing the**
7 **Clerk to refer this request to the San Francisco Local Agency Formation Commission**
8 **with certain information.**

9 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has approved motions (1) calling for a special
10 election for the purpose of submitting to the voters a proposal to form a municipal utility
11 district requested by petition pursuant to the Municipal Utility District Act (Public Utilities
12 Code Sections 11501 *et seq.*), and (2) establishing wards for the proposed municipal utility
13 district election; and

14 WHEREAS, The petition called for a municipal utility district with the same exterior
15 boundaries as the City and County of San Francisco and the City of Brisbane; and

16 WHEREAS, Upon receipt of the petition, the Board of Supervisors appointed
17 members to the San Francisco Local Agency Formation Commission and referred the
18 petition to that body; and

19 WHEREAS, After considering the matter, the San Francisco Local Agency Formation
20 Commission transmitted the petition to the Board of Supervisors with directions that the
21 Board call for an election on the formation of a municipal utility district and to divide the
22 proposed districts into five wards from which to elect directors for the district; and

23 WHEREAS, The Board and the San Francisco Local Agency Formation Commission
24 have received conflicting advice regarding the appropriate procedure for consideration and

1 action by a Local Agency Formation Commission on a petition to create and maintain a
2 municipal utility district; and

3 WHEREAS, State legislative amendments are under consideration that may affect the
4 procedures for the formation of municipal utility districts; and

5 WHEREAS, The deregulation of power in the State has resulted in an energy crisis
6 and substantial uncertainty with respect to the policies that the State will adopt in response
7 to that crisis; and

8 WHEREAS, The referral of this request to the San Francisco Local Agency Formation
9 Commission will enable the Commission to take such action as it deems appropriate with
10 respect to the creation and maintenance of the "San Francisco-Brisbane Municipal Utility
11 District"; now, therefore, be it

12 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby declares that in the Board's opinion
13 the public interest or necessity demands the creation and maintenance of a municipal utility
14 district with the same exterior boundaries as the City and County of San Francisco and the
15 City of Brisbane, to be known as the "San Francisco-Brisbane Municipal Utility District"; and,
16 be it

17 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board directs the Clerk of the Board to refer this request
18 to the San Francisco Local Agency Formation Commission for its consideration and action
19 pursuant to Part 3 of Division 3 of the Government Code, with a map and description of the
20 boundaries of the proposed municipal utility district and with notice that the persons to whom
21 the executive officer of the Commission is to provide reports, notices, and other
22 communications are the President and Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.
