I'm following up on how the Solaris battery electric bus warranty compares to New Flyer.

The general (i.e. complete bus) warranty is the same under both contracts: 2 years or 100,000 miles.

However, the warranties for some of the components (e.g., fire suppression and passenger seating) is longer under the Solaris contract compared to New Flyer.
