

1 [Apply for Grant - United States Department of Housing and Urban Development - Continuum
2 of Care Program - Anticipated Revenue in Excess of \$16,000,000]

3 **Resolution approving the 2026 grant application for the United States Department of**
4 **Housing and Urban Development Continuum of Care Program with anticipated revenue**
5 **to the City in excess of \$16,000,000; and fulfilling the Board of Supervisors review and**
6 **approval process for all annual or otherwise recurring grants of \$5,000,000 or more.**

8 WHEREAS, During the San Francisco 2024 Continuum of Care (CoC) competition,
9 San Francisco and its nonprofits were awarded \$56,140,078 to support San Francisco's
10 community efforts to end homelessness and these contracts were extended in 2025 without a
11 CoC competition process; and

12 WHEREAS, The 2026 CoC Notice of Funding Opportunity ("2026 NOFO") was
13 released on June 1, 2026, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors
14 in File No. 260796; and

15 WHEREAS, Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires submission of the 2026
16 CoC Application by August 24, 2026; however, as of the July 7, 2026, HUD has not yet
17 released the Application; and

18 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Local Homeless Coordinating Board ("LHCB") serves
19 as the lead entity that oversees the CoC process and programs, including the creation of
20 program priorities, funding categories, application guidelines, and scoring tools; and

21 WHEREAS, The LHCB plans to submit the 2026 CoC Application with anticipated
22 revenue to the City in excess of \$16,000,000 of which an amount greater than \$5,000,000
23 passes through the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing ("HSH"); and

24 WHEREAS, The LHCB has been meeting monthly to advise on the City's CoC
25 processes and programs, including receiving community input and participation in the

development of program priorities, application scoring criteria, and application guidelines and process; and

WHEREAS, The LHCB is expected to meet on August 3, 2026, to approve the 2026 CoC Application; and

WHEREAS, Under San Francisco Ordinance No. 256-05, the appropriate City department shall submit to the Board of Supervisors a Resolution articulating its grant application, as well as funding categories, for all annual grant applications of \$5,000,000 or more; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, The Application requires Board of Supervisors approval under Ordinance No. 265-05; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the LHCB and HSH are authorized to submit a 2026 CoC Application with anticipated revenue to the City in excess of \$16,000,000.
