3 **Motion ordering submitted to the voters an ordinance authorizing the amending San**
4 **Francisco Administrative Code Section 4.24 to allow the Recreation and Park**
5 **Department to enter into an agreement for the naming of City-owned sports stadium**
6 **located at Candlestick Point, and to use fifty percent of the revenue from the agreement**
7 **to fund recreation center directors at an election to be held on November 3, 2009.**

9 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby submits the following ordinance to the
10 voters of the City and County of San Francisco, at an election to be held on November 3,
11 2009.

13 **Ordinance amending San Francisco Administrative Code Section 4.24 to allow the**
14 **Recreation and Park Department to enter into an agreement for the naming of City-**
15 **owned sports stadium located at Candlestick Point, and to use fifty percent of the**
16 **revenue from the agreement to fund recreation center directors.**

19 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

20 Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending
21 Section 4.24, to read as follows:

22 Sec. 4.24. NAMING THE CITY-OWNED STADIUM "~~CANDLESTICK PARK~~" AT
23 CANDLESTICK POINT

1 ~~The City-owned sports stadium located at Candlestick Point, at Jamestown Street and~~
2 ~~Harney Way, is hereby named and shall be referred to as "Candlestick Park." This ordinance shall not~~
3 ~~apply to any privately-owned facility that may in the future be constructed at that location.~~

4 The Recreation and Park Department is authorized to approve, or enter into, an agreement for
5 the naming of the City-owned sports stadium located at Candlestick Point, at Jamestown Street and
6 Harney Way, subject to approval by the Board of Supervisors. It shall be City policy, subject to the
7 budgetary and fiscal provisions of the San Francisco Charter, that not less than fifty percent (50%) of
8 the revenue received by the City from any such agreement shall be used to fund Recreation and Park
9 Department recreation center directors.
