3	Resolution concurring with the controller's certification that paratransit services for the
4	Municipal Transportation Agency can be practically performed by a private contractor
5	at a lower cost than by city and county employees.

7	WHEREAS, Section 10.104.15 of the San Francisco Charter
8	allows Departments to contract for services when it has been determined by the Controller
9	and approved by a resolution of the Board of Supervisors to be economical; and
10	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency
11	is required by the federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 to provide paratransit
12	services for persons with disabilities who are unable to use fixed-route public transit; and
13	WHEREAS, The Office of Controller has determined that for fiscal year 2002-03,
14	contracting for paratransit services with outside firms at fixed unit cost rates is more
15	economical than providing the same services with City employees; and,
16	WHEREAS, The Controller's certification is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
17	Supervisors in File No; now, therefore be it
18	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors concurs with the Controller's determination
19	that paratransit services for the Municipal Railway can be practically performed by a private
20	contractor at a lower cost than by City and County employees for the period of fiscal year
21	2002-03.
