WHEREAS, MCF mobilizes hundreds of volunteers that reflect the diversity of the City to augment minimal staff at the foundation and to assist providing services to needy, and

WHEREAS, Renewed funding and the continuation of this critical Shower program will reduce the suffering of the City's most vulnerable citizens and provide a crucial springboard to transition individuals and families from homelessness to permanent housing and adequate social, educational and employment services; now therefore, be it
